World Meeting of Families and Papal Mass
The only way to guarantee a ticket to the Papal Mass on Sunday 26th August is to attend the Congress on 22nd, 23rd or 24th August in the RDS.

A day ticket plus coach to the RDS will be around £50. Local parishes will organise a coach if there is sufficient demand. Tickets for the Papal Mass will be free but *An Garda Síochána* have limited numbers to 400,000. Contact the Parish Office if you would like to go to the RDS stating which day you would prefer.
